## Sector Improvement Profile: Farmed Salmon

About 37% of the world's farmed salmon production is yellow- or red-rated, indicating that improvements are needed, and more than 38% is status unknown. Our improvement efforts prioritize:

- The 35% of global farmed salmon production that is red-rated; and
- The 12% within the scope of Sustainable Fisheries Partnership's Target 75 Initiative.
