Sector Improvement Profile: Shrimp

About 47% of the world's shrimp production is yellow- or red-rated, indicating that improvements are needed, and approximately 40% is status unknown. Our improvement efforts prioritize:

- The 40% of global shrimp production that is red-rated; and
- The 44% within the scope of Sustainable Fisheries Partnership's Target 75 Initiative.
